

Fondo Elena Moroni for Oncology, Torino, Italy Enrico Anglesio Prize, 2023

Rules and Procedures

Since 2006, the Enrico Anglesio Prize (EAP) has been awarded to a young researcher (35 years of age, or less) who has prepared an original work in the domain of Epidemiology and Cancer Registration. From 2006 to 2022, over two hundreds young researchers contested, and 31 have been declared Enrico Anglesio Laureate (or Laureate of the two satellite Special Prizes awarded for the 2020-2022 editions) at the GRELL or at the IACR round.

In years 2020-2022, with the cancellation of the scientific conferences in person, where the Prize was awarded, the Fondo Elena Moroni maintained this appointment with a new at distance formula that kept the spirit of competitiveness, not only in the scientific quality, but also in the way the message is delivered, and results are communicated.

For year 2023, IACR resumes the in-person format. The next scientific meeting of IACR is organized jointly with the European Network of Cancer Registries (ENCR) and will be held the **14th-16th November in Granada**.

Also the Fondo Elena Moroni, in its turn, is ready to resume the in-person Enrico Anglesio Prize (EAP) to be delivered at the closure of the conference with a dedicated Award Ceremony, **keeping its registration** (here link to the registration form) **and selection process in two steps**.

EAP 2023 Two steps: Dissertation (long abstract) and Video

Please note that the contender must be the first author (unique first - no shared first authorship allowed) of the dissertation, and the presenter of the video clip.

1) DISSERTATION

Manuscripts must be in English and prepared according to the following format similar to a short article:

a) 1000 words max – references, tables and figures (respectively 10, 2, 2 max) excluded, and;

b) manuscripts have to be structured in Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion

2) VIDEO PRESENTATION (8-minutes-long)

The finalists are free to decide the style of their video presentations. Ideally it should mix images of the candidate presenting and slides with figures and tables.

A short list of finalists will be selected by the Jury of the Enrico Anglesio Prize.

The winner will be awarded a 500 € prize. If the winning work is published, **with the Prize Winner as first author**, within one year on a scientific journal with impact factor, the prize amount will be multiplied upon publication. The basic amount of the Prize is doubled to 1000 Euro if the work is published on a Journal with impact factor over 4.00; it is multiplied by three (reaching 1500 Euro) if the work is published on a journal with impact factor over 8.00. The Enrico Anglesio Prize must be mentioned in the acknowledgments of the article. **The rule of multiplication upon publication apply only to the Enrico Anglesio main prize, and not to the Satellite Special Prizes, unless otherwise specified**

One year for publication means that 365 days is the maximum time allowed between the date of the award ceremony and the date of the acceptance letter from the journal to which the paper has been successfully submitted.

Both the basic amount of the Prize and its multiplication when the case, are payable to the winner within the mid of December of the corresponding year.

The prize award and the title of the research will be successively announced through the websites and the newsletter of various organizations and some scientific journals

The timetable for the [EAP 2023](#) is as follow:

- 1.. The contest for the EAP 2023 will be officially announced and opened on **July 26th, 2023**
- 2.. By **September 15**, the application form, CV and the **text of the written dissertation** are expected to be sent to the Fondo Elena Moroni. The arrival of the application will be acknowledged to the sender by e-mail.
- 3.. By **the end of September** the Enrico Anglesio Prize Jury will have

completed the selection of the finalists and will notify them, soon after.

4.. By **October 31** the finalists are expected to send their video and will receive confirmation of the arrival.

5.. The **16th of November** the winners will be declared during *an in-person ceremony taking place in Granada at the closing of the IACR Scientific Conference*.

Applying to the Enrico Anglesio Prize, awarded by Fondo Elena Moroni.

1.. Candidates must not be older than 35 years of age; the criterion includes all those candidates that turn 35 during 2023.

2.. The candidate is the first author (unique first - **no shared first authorship allowed**) of the dissertation, and the presenter of the video clip.

3.. The submitted study was not previously presented, submitted, or published elsewhere. **Exceptions** are presentations to other conferences within the current year. Nevertheless, candidates are invited to notify this to the EAP Jury and they are encouraged to contact the Jury Chair before applying and during all the contest's stages to look into any aspect that could appear conflicting with the originality rule.

The Fondo Elena Moroni grants that the manuscripts will not be circulated outside the Jury, and it will not be used for scopes other than Enrico Anglesio Prize participation.

The online posting of the videos at the Fondo Elena Moroni website is regulated by conditions detailed in the disclaimer form (*in Italian, the language of the legal jurisdiction of the contest*).

5.. By the above-mentioned deadline, candidates must send the following items **through the on-line application form available on the EAP web page (<http://www.fondoelenamoroni.org/en/the-prize/>):**

A.. The application form, disclaimer form, CV form and a brief biosketch, duly filled in and signed.

B.. The candidate's picture.

C.. The candidate's text of the Dissertation

6.. By the above-mentioned deadline, the finalists must send their video

presentations **through the on-line video form available on the EAP web page (<http://www.fondoelenamoroni.org/en/the-prize/>):**.

7.. At the end of the contest participants can reach out the FEM (info@fondoelenamoroni.org) to know their detailed scores.

Applications from all the young researchers working with/at Cancer Registries and/or in Descriptive Epidemiology of Cancer worldwide are welcome. Candidates are also strongly encouraged to attend the IACR Annual Conference, but attendance to the conference is not a pre-requisite for participation to the contest.

FEM and EAP Jury are strongly committed to improve the quality of the contest and the fairness of the selection process. Feedback, comments and suggestions are always welcomed, and candidates are invited to reach out FEM in case of questions.
