

Fondo Elena Moroni for Oncology, Torino, Italy Enrico Anglesio Prize, 2026

Rules and Procedures

The Enrico Anglesio Prize (EAP) is awarded to a young researcher (for this year's round, the age limit is set to 40 years of age or less) who submits an original work in Cancer Epidemiology, Cancer Registration and Oncology. Studies on methodology, descriptive data analysis or clinical studies are all well accepted.

EAP Submissions

Both Dissertation and Video Presentation can be sent at once or separately, no submission order is strictly required

Candidates will receive a password for uploading their submissions

EAP Dissertation (long abstract) format

Please note that the contender must be the first author (unique first - no shared first authorship allowed) of the dissertation, and the presenter of the video clip.

Manuscripts must be in English and prepared according to the following format, similar to a short article:

- a) 1000 words max – references (max 20), tables (max 2) and figures (max 2) excluded, and;
- b) manuscripts have to be structured in Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion
- c) manuscripts can be uploaded through the same link as for the registration form at the following link:

EAP Video Presentation format

The video clip must be a maximum of 8-minutes-long

The EAP candidates are free to decide the style of their video presentations. Ideally, it should mix images of the candidate presenting and slides with figures and tables.

All the video presentations received will be accessible from the Prize webpage after the end of the contest; we are also considering posting them on the web as single YouTube videos within the frame of the EAP 2026. Of course, this posting will be realised in agreement with each of you, and with a timing compatible with your desires and constraints for publishing your results elsewhere in the online or printed literature.

A selection of competitors will be invited to take an active role during the Award Ceremony, with a “**rapid-fire**” two-minute summary presentation.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING THE VIDEO PRESENTATION

To prepare your video please use **YouTube Studio**

How to upload videos in YouTube Studio

1. Sign in to [YouTube Studio](#).
2. In the top right-hand corner, click **CREATE** > **Upload video**.
3. Select the file you want to upload.
4. Open the **Visibility** page to choose your video’s [privacy setting](#) and set it as **UNLISTED**

Be aware that if you close the upload window before you finish choosing your settings, your video will be saved as a draft on your Videos page.

After finished uploading, please send the video link using the link:

with the same Passcode previously provided for uploading the dissertation and video.

Your video will be handled by the Fondo Elena Moroni and by the Jury of the Prize according to the warranties that you signed in your application form.

The winner will be awarded a 500 € prize. If the winning work is published, **with the Prize Winner as the first author, within one year** in a scientific journal with an impact factor, the prize amount will be multiplied upon publication. The basic amount of the Prize is doubled to 1000 Euro if the work is published in a Journal with an impact factor over 4.00; it is multiplied by three (reaching 1500 Euro) if the work is published in a journal with an impact factor over 8.00.

The Enrico Anglesio Prize must be mentioned in the acknowledgements of the article.

The rule of multiplication upon publication applies only to the Enrico Anglesio main prize, and not to the Satellite Special Prizes unless otherwise specified

One year for publication means that 365 days is the maximum time allowed between the date of the award ceremony and the date of the acceptance letter from the journal to which the paper has been successfully submitted.

Both the basic amount of the Prize and its multiplication when the case, are payable to the winner within the middle of December of the corresponding year.

The prize award and the title of the research will be successively announced through the websites and the newsletters of various organisations and some scientific journals

The timetable for the [EAP 2026](#) is as follows:

- 1.. The contest for the EAP 2026 will be opened on the **17th of May, 2026**
- 2.. By **September 20**, the candidates must send their application form, together with the required documents (CV, Disclaimer, and the candidate's picture)
- 3.. By **October 18** the **text of the written dissertation and the Video Presentation** are expected to be sent/uploaded to the Fondo Elena Moroni.
- 4.. On the **20th of November** the winners will be declared during *an online ceremony*.

Applying to the Enrico Anglesio Prize, awarded by Fondo Elena Moroni.

- 1.. Candidates must not be older than 40 years of age; the criterion includes all those candidates that turn 40 during 2025.
- 2.. The candidate is the first author (unique first - **no shared first authorship allowed**) of the dissertation, and the presenter of the video clip.
- 3.. The submitted study was **not** previously **published** elsewhere at the date of the award ceremony. Nevertheless, candidates are invited to notify the EAP Jury and they are encouraged to contact the Jury Chair before applying and during all the contest's stages to look into any aspect that could appear to conflict with the originality rule.

The Fondo Elena Moroni grants that the manuscripts will not be circulated outside the Jury, and they will not be used for scopes other than Enrico Anglesio Prize participation.

The online posting of the videos at the Fondo Elena Moroni website is regulated by conditions detailed in the disclaimer form (*in Italian, the language of the legal jurisdiction of the contest*).

- 4.. By the above-mentioned deadline, candidates must send the following items **through the online application form available on the EAP web page (<http://www.fondoelenamoroni.org/en/the-prize/>):**

- A.. The application form, disclaimer form, CV form and a brief biosketch, duly filled in and signed.
- B.. The candidate's picture.
- C.. The candidate's text of the Dissertation

5.. By the above-mentioned deadline, the finalists must send their dissertations and video presentations **through the online upload form sent to the candidates upon registration with their passwords.**

6.. At the end of the contest participants can reach out to the FEM (info@fondolenamoroni.org) to know their detailed scores.

Applications from all the young researchers working with/at Cancer Registries and/or in Cancer Epidemiology worldwide are welcome.

FEM and EAP Jury are strongly committed to improving the quality of the contest and the fairness of the selection process. Feedback, comments and suggestions are always welcomed, and candidates are invited to reach out FEM in case of questions.
